California dmv real id processing time

Californians can continue to apply for these standard driver's licenses, but they won't be able to use them for federal purposes, such as boarding a domestic commercial flight starting in October 2020. California DMV California Department of Motor Vehicles is starting to accept applications today for Real ID driver's licenses and government identification cards. These are licenses and IDs that will be required to board a domestic flight, enter federal buildings and visit military installations starting in 2020. Here's what Californians need to know about Real ID licenses, how to get them, and how necessary they will be. Q: What is a real license or IDENTIFICATION card driver's license? It is a license or ID that complies with the Real ID Act, a law passed by Congress in 2005 after 9/11 that sought to create standardized driver's licenses in all states. The law established certain national security requirements for these state-issued documents. Starting October 1, 2020, travelers who board domestic commercial flights, enter a military base or use their ID for other federal purposes will be required to present a driver's license compatible with a real ID or state ID. While licenses or ID cards that are incompatible with licenses are not accepted, people may present other documents compatible with federal documents such as passport, passport or military ID for flights and other federal purposes. Q: Do I need to get a license for a genuine ID or ID? No, it's not. It's just an easy way for you to keep using your driver's license to board a domestic flight. That's really the bulk of it. Californians who are unwilling to obtain a license for a genuine ID or ID in the state can apply for what is called a federal non-compliant driver's license or ID. The card will be marked with the words federal restrictions applied. Californians who choose this option can continue to use their government licenses to drive and use it the way they do now. But they won't be able to use them starting in 2020 to take a domestic flight, for example. If they do not have a license for a real ID or ID, they will need to present a passport or other approved document for the flight. Q: How does this affect AB 60 driver's license holders? According to the California DMV, the changes do not apply to nearly a million immigrants who have a driver's license under A.B. 60, which allows unauthorized immigrants in the state to apply for licenses. According to the DMV, only people who are legally in the United States can apply for a License or Real ID. If you already have an A.B. 60 driver's license, when it is time for you to renew, you are you just keep resuming by mail, or online as usual. Gonzalez told DMV. She added that information about A.B. 60 license applicants would not be shared with the federal government. Q: Should those who want a Real ID license apply immediately? No, there is no rush, according to DMV officials. Until October 1, 2020, a valid California driver's license can still be used to board a domestic flight, or to enter a secure facility. Today is simply the date when the Real ID option becomes available to California residents. Q: How do I apply? Those wishing to apply for a Real ID license or IDENTIFICATION card must do so in person at the DMV office. Applicants must make an appointment and come prepared with a California residence confirmation, confirmation of their Social Security number, as well as proof of identity such as a U.S. passport, birth certificate, employment permit document, permanent resident card (green card) or international passport with approved I-94 arrival and departure form. The DMV has published a list of documents that Real ID applicants can use. the cost is the same as for a regular California driver's license, \$35. The cost is \$30 for government ID cards. DMV officials said the processing time should be about four weeks. COVID-19 update: Due to the circumstances resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic and the national declaration of emergency, the Department of Homeland Security extended the real ID deadline from October 1, 2020 to October 1, 2021, as published in the April 27, 2020, notice in the Federal Register. Starting October 1, 2021, passengers who wish to continue using their driver's license or ID to board a domestic flight will be required to present a federal REAL ID driver's license or special-label ID. To obtain one of these cards, a person must contact the California Department of Motor Vehicles and provide federal documentation. The REAL ID card is optional. A person may use other federal identification, such as a valid U.S. passport, to pass through airport security, and to enter secure federal buildings and military facilities. States across the country have been offering driver's licenses and REAL ID identification cards since the 9/11 Commission recommended in 2005 the federal government set uniform standards for state identification cards. The Department of Homeland Security will enforce these new standards on October 1, 2021. Until then, all valid California driver's licenses and identification cards will be accepted at airport checkpoints for domestic air travel. Applying for ID Any person interested in applying for a driver's license/ID with a REAL ID sign is obliged to personally visit the DMV field office and present specific documentation: Identity verification (U.S. birth certificate, valid U.S. passport, permanent resident card, passport approved form I-94. School ID is not accepted for payment). Note: A name change document, such as a marriage certificate or adoption documents filed with the court, is required if you have legally changed your name. Confirmation of social security number (Social Security card, form W-2, paystub with full SSN). Confirmation of California address (rental agreement, cell phone bill, official school documents that include your birthday). A complete list of accepted documents and an interactive checklist are available REALID.dmv.ca.gov. Original or certified copies are required to verify identity and social security (without photocopies or images). You can bring a copy to verify your California address, but the DMV won't accept email files. The best time to apply for your real ID is when your driver's license is to continue. The DMV encourages you to apply within 60 days of the expiration date and go to an appointment up to 90 days in advance. Be sure to fill out the application online in advance in eDLapp.dmv.ca.gov. If your driver's license or ID appears for renewal after October 2021, you can apply for a card with a REAL ID sign before that federal enforcement date. Remember that if you have a valid passport or other federally approved document, you can also use it. If you renew your license online or by mail, or if you don't provide all the necessary documents responding in person, you'll get a federal license that doesn't meet the terms and conditions, with the phrase Federal Restrictions applied. Federal cards incompatible with federal cards are not accepted as identification at airport checkpoints since October 1, 2021. The Real ID, issued in California, will display a grizzly bear and a star in the top right corner. An unresponsive federal card will have federal restrictions applied in that area. Any card still allows you to drive, apply for or receive federal benefits, introduce federal facilities such as post offices, visit hospitals and receive lifesaving services. The process seemed to be moving along for Harden. He's one of about six million Californians who have applied for real ID, so far. Last year, the California DMV deployed real-life admies that were ultimately inconsistent with the federal government's standard. Officials said most of those applicants were re-vetted. We sent two million plus documents to the people who received these, and we got the majority of those who came back. So people now re-verify their real ID by sending this secondary document a residency document. So for the most part those are under control, but there are still a few that are not, Steve Gordon, director of the California DMV said. Now, officials hope the new walking center and 30-minute processing time will help the estimated 16 million Californians apply now. But to apply, applicants will have to bring either a passport or birth certificate, their Social Security number and two documents showing a California residence - like a utility bill or a bank statement. He's moving straight ahead. Once you get the roster, its smooth sailing. Yes, so far so good,' Harden said. It will take Harden about 2-6 weeks to get his new license with a federal complaint real id bear and star symbol.
